China International Co-Production

The government requires certain conditions for granting co-production status in China.

Your project should include the following:

1

Chinese theme or elements



2

1/3 or more Chinese leading members of cast i.e. actors/actresses



3

In principle, no less than 20% production investment from China



Official China co-productions are treated as domestic films which receive 43% of the box office.

Procedure for Approval of Co-Production Films

Application for Approval

Sino-foreign coproduction parties sign letter of intent Submit script and documents to provincial film authority;
Script Review

Script Review

Submit script and comments given by provincial film authority plus related documents to CFCC

CFCC submits the package to SAPPRFT after conducting preliminary review of script and related documents

Approval & Filming

SAPPRFT issues Film
Production Permit to CFCC
after conducting final review
and approval of script and
related documents

CFCC in turn forwards the permit to the production company (with a CFCC cover letter)

Visas & Import Formalities

Apply to CFCC for entry visas for foreign crew where applicable

Produce letter of attorney and equipment list to entrust to CFCC for customs clearance where applicable

Completed Film

Provincial film authority provides CFCC with the completed film for final approval
